

For Foreign Residents Living in Kanagawa who Wish to Study and Work as Certified Care Worker

Assistance with fees to obtain Certified Care Worker License

Student Loan to Become Certified Care Worker

A loan is provided for those enrolled in vocational schools to obtain the license to work as certified care workers (Kaigo Fukushishi)

You are exempted from the payment if certain conditions are met, such as completing 5 years of work as certified care worker in Kanagawa.

This loan is designated for those who are or plan to be enrolled in vocational school to obtain certified care worker license, where you are expected to have Japanese proficiency level equivalent to JLPT N2.
